#### I. CALL TO ORDER

#### II. NEW BUSINESS

Dr. Monks provided an update on the following items:

# A. Call for Nominations: Committee on Student Affairs (2 medical educator seats)

- The PLFSOM Faculty Council is seeking nominations to fill two (2) medical educator seats on the PLFSOM Committee on Student Affairs.
- Eligible faculty must be a voting faculty member of PLFSOM (0.5 FTE or more) and their primary appointment is in the department of Medical Education.
- The Committee on Student Affairs is charged with deliberating on matters related to student morale and the learning environment, serving in an advisory capacity to the Dean regarding concerns and recommendation to better support students, and to review relevant policies on a biannual schedule.
- Members shall be appointed for three (3)-year terms. This committee is scheduled to meet quarterly. An email will be sent out to the faculty with a call for nominations. The deadline to submit nominations is January 13, 2023.

# **B.** Emeritus Appointment Nominations

- The following retired faculty members have been nominated by their department chairs
  for an emeritus appointment. Per HSCEP OP 10.12, the PLFSOM Faculty Council is to
  review nominations for emeritus appointments and then forward their recommendation
  to the Dean. Emeritus appointments are strictly honorary and can be given to faculty after
  retirement who have completed at least ten years of faithful service or very distinguished
  service to the institution. Emeritus appointments are subject to final vote and approval by
  the TTU Board of Regents.

## <u>Curriculum and Educational Policy Committee (CEPC):</u>

The Faculty Council is still seeking nominations to fill one (1) basic sciences seat on the PLFSOM Curriculum and Educational Policy Committee.

- This Committee is charged with the development, design, implementation, evaluation, and revision of the undergraduate medical education curriculum to ensure continuous quality improvement.
- Eligible faculty must be a voting faculty member of PLFSOM (0.5 FTE or more) and this seat must be filled by a basic sciences faculty member.
- Term of service is 4 years. Meetings typically occur monthly.
- An email will be sent out to the faculty with a call for nominations. The deadline to submit nominations is January 13, 2023.

# Committee on Student Grading and Promotion:

The PLFSOM Faculty Council is seeking nominations to fill one (1) seat on the PLFSOM Committee on Student Grading and Promotion.

- The committee is charged with evaluating reports of grades and other performance evaluations of students and making decisions regarding student promotion, remediation and dismissal.
- All PLFSOM faculty members with an FTE of 50% or greater in a department with teaching responsibilities in the undergraduate medical curriculum are eligible to serve.
- The committee meets on the third Friday of each month. Interested faculty members must be available to meet with no scheduling conflicts. Please talk to faculty in your department and submit your nominations by emailing fservices@ttuhsc.edu by January 13, 2023.
