- **Q.** Can you elaborate on the change of the interview style? Why does this style better suit our institution?
- **A.** Half the medical school cohort across the nation uses this format. When multiple committee members are able to interview each of the applicants and evaluate them, it provides more consistent feedback versus having two long scale interviews. There are eight evaluators that get to talk to each applicant and provide feedback on performance. There are advantages and disadvantages of the two formats but the biggest advantage is having more people evaluate each applicant.
- **Q.** Does this format also provide opportunities to ask specific questions about their application or their personal statements? Or vice versa, does this provide the candidate the opportunity to ask us about our institution?
- A. No, that is one of the downsides with this format. It is so quick and each evaluator only has about five minutes to speak with each of the applicants. This doesn't allow the evaluator to dig deeper into specific questions but this is something the committee can discuss. From time to time the committee looks further into an applicant's letters of reference or their application when there are discrepancies or performance issues. This is definitely a change that has some advantages and disadvantages. I think it has worked well so far.
- **Comment Dr. Meza**: I think virtual interviews are a recommendation from AAMC. I think as long as you are consistent with your format, I think you meet the requirement. It is advantageous to do inperson interviews versus virtual. Also, you need to be fair in your opportunities and if one interview is virtual then the others should be as well.

A list of recommended candidates to be offered positions through the Texas Medical and Dental School Application Service (TMDSAS) matching process will be prepared based on a ranking determined following deliberations by the Committee. The Committee also shall have the responsibility to review the requirements for admission and, if necessary, to recommend revisions to the faculty.
